Monday where it was no wind. I played this morning where there was no wind but all of a sudden, it's a flip of a switch and it gets so windy out here and makes it very difficult.

Q. We had the wind yesterday, a lot of sun today. How do you prepare for the conditions that we might be getting this weekend?

NELLY KORDA: Just kind of new day, fresh start. Kind of have to make your game plan like that.
