SEI YOUNG KIM: Yeah.

Q. You told me you're learning to love links. Didn't play too much growing up and don't play much links in



the year. It's a different test.

SEI YOUNG KIM: It is. When I play the first couple years I was really struggle with links course. I don't know how to play like because around the green is very firmer than the normal golf course.

So I have to learn how to play here. So, yeah, just spend time a lot and now is, yeah, I feel like a little bit know about it.
