JEENO THITIKUL: No. I was just do -- I was just trying to do the same, like we had nothing to do. Just trying to go for the fairway, we trying to find the best that we can get near the pin, and then make the putt. Simple strategy.

Q. And are you looking at the leaderboard at all when you're out there?

JEENO THITIKUL: Today a little bit, a little bit. I just want to know are they all finish because I want to finish. That's pretty much it.

Q. And when you got done I asked you what are you eating, what are you doing to perform at such a high level. Can you just talk about the local tie you have to the Thai restaurant here?

JEENO THITIKUL: Yes, I do have one restaurant that own our dinner like every single day in CME, like every single years too. So the name of the restaurant is Sushi Thai Too, if I say it right. But I believe it is, but it's so many branch of it.

And then like the owner is Thai and he walk with me recently like every round that I play here in CME and then they're really nice. You're far away from home, to be able



to eat the food that you would love it and then the food that you're used to just feel like home.
