Q. How do you think you took advantage of the calmer conditions, especially as you said, wanting to have a couple more birdies on the card today?

BIANCA PAGDANGANAN: I don't know, I feel like some of the pins were still pretty tough. It's all about really playing smart out here, knowing where to miss. I definitely hit a lot



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more greens today which helped. Putting felt really good.

So I hit a couple of them pretty close so just tried to take advantage of those short birdies. But, yeah, bogey-free is always good.

Q. Lowest of the morning wave so far. How do you hope to capitalize tomorrow on the final day?

BIANCA PAGDANGANAN: No idea honestly. I am just going to chill. I was pretty chill today. My mind felt really calm. If I could do that again tomorrow, that'd be great.
