Q. Carlota, what is it about the Solheim Cup that provides those moments?

CARLOTA CIGANDA: I love this week. I just love playing for the team, for my teammates. Anna is a good friend of mine, so I just want to win for her. We had a tough match against Nelly and Lauren, very consistent, but we fought hard and at least we got half a point, which I think is really important.
