Q. When we talked yesterday after the morning session you were pretty happy with the tied ball game. Is that still the case going into today?

ANGELA STANFORD: Absolutely. I mean, look, today's going to be tough and we know that. But I feel like we're built for it and we're ready. But, yeah, I think if you can be tied or even up, I mean that's a win over here. I don't think people understand how tough it's been to play here.
