Q. We talked a little bit about the tight fairways. How do you mentally stay in the game throughout the round? There is never a break it sounds like.

GEMMA DRYBURGH: No.

Q. So how do you maintain that?

GEMMA DRYBURGH: Yeah, we just said like there is no hole that you can open up your shoulders and go for it. There is always tight fairways on every hole pretty much, and if you miss the fairway it's penalizing.

You have to focus on a line and trust yourself, so tried to do that today. I did miss some fairways, but kept it pretty

straight overall.
