And if you start off a round with consecutive birdies, obviously you can be really comfortable about your game. And I think that allowed me to remain calm and focused.

Q. Another top finish to add to your year. How will you use this win and this momentum to carry on to the end of the season?

DA YEON LEE: I'm going to take a break next week, and then we have two events left, and I think I'll try to prepare as much as I can in terms of the technical side and also just in terms of general stamina.

And I think if I just keep focused on my play, I can look forward to the results in the remaining two events.
