Q. Here with Hyo Joo Kim. Evaluate your round. Pretty solid day it looked like.

HYO JOO KIM: So I think I created a lot more chances today than I did yesterday. Although I did miss a couple of chances that I created, but overall, it wasn't too bad and I think if I focus a little bit more tomorrow, I'll be able to do better.
