Q. Can you just talk about your performance, four rounds in the 60s is awesome.

HANNAH GREEN: Yeah, obviously it has been a while since I've had this form. So it's nice to see what I've been working on is actually paying off. Yeah, definitely I think the team at home helped with the mental reset, just not getting too ahead of myself and not thinking too much into the future. Yeah, I am really pleased with today's round. I got off to a heater. So it was nice to finish strong with three birdies to end.

Q. How much did you enjoy yourself this week?

HANNAH GREEN: It was really nice. I think coming back to a place where I am defending, I put a bit more pressure on myself but I think -- I felt like my game was good. It was nice to have some good results but I also had some good people to play with. Played with Minjee a couple times this week. That's nice leading into the International Crown. But good pairings and hitting better shots makes it better on the golf course.

Q. How freeing was it today to play out there?

HANNAH GREEN: I had a couple really wild tee shots, and I made the best par of my life, I think on the 10th hole. Just knowing that I can bounce back from that, yeah, not really think about the negative stuff, and then go to make some birdies, I guess that was what I was proud of today.

Q. You have a great record of title defenses and playing well. What can you say about that?

HANNAH GREEN: It is funny, I don't know why, and especially this year, we have changed venues, so I don't have history at the golf course. But having that inner confidence that I can actually get a trophy in my hands when I do play well.

Q. What inner strength have you been working on that you said you saw this week?

Just going back to basic, nothing out of the ordinary.

Q. What are you looking forward to the most about travel there and what it looks like for the week?

HANNAH GREEN: Yeah, we are all very excited and we are all competitive against one another. Hopefully that will show when we are playing on the golf course. We're really excited and I wouldn't be surprised if we do well, because we have a good team bond and that is very important for this tournament.

HANNAH GREEN: I guess we're close enough that we don't have a group chat. We don't have one with the caddies but that would be one we'll make next.
