So taking it all in stride and just hoping for the best. I'm going to go out there and try it win it tomorrow.

Q. What positive vibes or memories from that win will you draw upon as you are in contention tomorrow?

ANDREA LEE: Yeah, I mean, I won in a playoff, three holes against Lucy Li who I'm also good friends with. I think just I was 1-down going into 17 and made a crazy birdie putt like 50 feet; it was wild.

But, yeah, like I said, just huge confidence booster. Played some really good golf that week and it's nice to see some low scores continuing.
