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stroke play. It's a lot more like one hole doesn't really matter here or there so like you can't get too down on yourself and you just got to battle and stay in it.

Where stroke play you can be out of it pretty quickly; whereas match play you're always in it.

ANGEL YIN: And I think it's great because we can always lean on each other. That's why we have teammates, and I think we built that trust over the short amount of time. But we've done it and I think it's showing.
