ANGEL YIN: Yeah, it's definitely better than Shanghai. I mean, I told my caddie in Shanghai when I was playing, my goal is to just play singles. Obviously I'm not -- you can always say you want to play singles, but I'm not going to play singles if I wasn't playing good.

So I mean, I think everything just worked out with the team chemistry, too. Just so happens I'm playing singles and everybody else is doing their thing and everybody has a role. I don't know, I think everybody is just doing good.

It's just good. Nothing to it really.

**Q. Why singles? You prefer singles or is that just a comfort thing?**

ANGEL YIN: It was not because like -- it was just for me to give myself reassurance that I'm playing better, to even like



consider myself, me, myself, to be able to put myself in singles.

You know, I was playing pretty bad in Shanghai. I think I was like second to last and really nothing was happening and I was really worried that that was going to drag down the team.

So my goal was to play singles not because, you know, of anything else, but just because if I'm going to play singles I'm playing better, right?

I don't know how to explain it. It's not like one person -- like this is like we really planned it out. It's not like because someone is playing better you're playing (indiscernible - hose spraying.)

Just the way it worked out. For me it was just a small goal for myself. I wanted to play good enough where I could play by myself. I don't know how else to explain it.

**Q. And then just last one: Obviously going to chat with the team here. Same strategy heading into the finals now?**

ANGEL YIN: We don't know. Going to talk with the team and see what we're going to come up with and move forward from there.
