Q. How was it to come back and out and play after not playing the last three?

RHAMONDRE STEVENSON: It felt great, being back out there with my team and fighting with them on this Sunday it felt good.

Q. And how about with Damien, did you have a chance to see him after the game and can you relay how he's hanging in?

Q. What was it like in the huddle on the final drive?

Just not really a game plan but just how we were thinking at the end of the game in the huddle, just let's do our job in the huddle and win the game.
