JAMIE COLLINS, SR: Feels good to get a win on the road. Always hard on the road to get a win and we pulled it out and kept fighting, kept fighting and we did it. Sack felt good obviously. Always to sack the quarterback, getting after the quarterback but it's even better when you win on the road.

JAMIE COLLINS, SR: We called the rush. Didn't work out how we wanted it to work out but you know we'll take it. Guy made a great play. He knocked the guy back into the punter. Punted off his head or something. We'll take it.

Q. Some might look at it, ball just goes off, what does it say about Lawrence to make that?

JAMIE COLLINS, SR: Yeah, from the sought I'd looking in, you look at it like that, but like you said, you don't see the guy across him make the play, which was Guy. Guy, he's a sneaky playmaker. He's always under the radar. He's



not -- he's not a flashy playmaker, put it like that, you know what I mean but he always making plays. That's what's great about guy. He's not a flashy may maker and they the best kinds for real.

Q. You guys pretty frustrated at halftime based how the first half went?

JAMIE COLLINS, SR: Yeah, down, come in here about starting slow. We always talk about starting fast and we didn't. We started very slow, especially on defense coming out. We was frustrated a little bit but we kept fighting and end result is the best thing and it worked out for the greater good.

Q. The final 28 minutes, can you put your finger on what you were able to do, keeping them scoreless?

JAMIE COLLINS, SR: Just keep fighting. Don't stop. Never get complacent. Maybe those guys got complacent over there, maybe they got too excited and was looking too far ahead. We was just one play at a time, taking it one play at a time and it all worked out.


Q. What was it about the plan initially the Texans were able to beat?
