Q. Congratulations on the birth of your daughter. Hopefully fatherhood is treating you well. Tonight's game, what did you think of the team's overall performance?

RAOUL PETRETTA: I think first half we were a little bit passive. I think and the chances we had to counter, we didn't do well. But when you play against a team that loves to have the ball, to be brave with the ball, be aggressive against the ball and brave with the ball. Defensively I think we were not that bad in the first half. Of course, we were deep, but with the ball, yeah, even me, I struggled a little bit to find the right position to play, to help the team come out with the ball.
