TRAVIS HUNTER: They called my number. They gave me the ball, and I did what I always do. I do my job.

TRAVIS HUNTER: He's always focused and always ready and always on top of his game so just having him in the room, you know you got to do your job because he's going to do his job. That's what he expects. He expects for all of us to do his job because we know he's going to do his.
