OTHMAN ALMULLA: Just the process really. It's so cliché. Everyone says that in interviews, but it's so easy, when you're out there four or five hours, to get ahead of yourself, think about the past, think about the present, but that kind of puts you behind the eight ball because you forget about what you're trying to do right here, right now.

I've been working really hard on my process, stick to what works. Know I have the capability to hit good shots through my practice and through my process.

I hit a lot of quality shots to 15 to 20 feet. Hit some really, really good putts. Those pins are in tough positions.

Obviously Caleb is going super, super low, so maybe he's got the greens down this week. But I just want to keep doing that. Just keep enjoying it. Again, I need to remember that it's such an amazing opportunity to play in Saudi Arabia in an international competition with the best people in the world and be grateful for that opportunity.

Who knows how many more of these? Like life's not infinite, right? You've got to take the good and the bad and kind of enjoy the opportunities you get. I just want to keep doing that.
