WADE ORMSBY: Yeah.

**Q. I wonder when you're talking about your -- how the game can -- how things...**

WADE ORMSBY: Change, yeah.

**Q. Was there pressure or no?**

WADE ORMSBY: I wouldn't say too much pressure. Like I probably didn't play my best golf in Jakarta. I putted nicely and that's why I won the golf tournament. So I knew I had work to do on my golf game and I probably ramped it up, putting too much focus mechanically on my golf game. That's fine. You learn from that and you keep on going.
