ANNE VAN DAM: It was good, a little bit of mixed bag. I think I had four bogeys, those were definitely not my best shots but then I made a ton of birdies out there so that was nice. I mean, the course definitely was scorable today. It was hardly any wind. I didn't think the pins were too tough.

So it was definitely -- you could definitely create some chances and yeah, especially today I'm happy with the early round to get a good score in.

PASQUALLE COFFA: I was playing quite solid from the beginning, a lot of birdie opportunities, and I just kept patient and I holed, I think, two or three 20-footers for par in the beginning which kept me going and gave me some confidence for the rest of round.
