HAZEL MacGARVIE: I tried not to think about that to be honest. I mean, yesterday, I got off to a pretty poor start honestly, could not control how much I was shaking. Not

We gave it a good push today, missed a couple putts here and there but pretty proud of how we've done.

LOUIS LEVESON: I have to say the first tee shot yesterday I was incredibly nervous. It was probably my best tee shot of the day. But no, it's just fantastic.
