Q. Incredible way to finish your campaign. Sum up the round today.

JOOST LUITEN: Yeah, it was a nice day to finish. 8-under on a Sunday at Wentworth is always good. Played well. Made some nice saves at the beginning and all the nice eagle putt on 4 to get the round going, and I played really well in the middle part. Four birdies in a row. Then it's nice to finish on 18. The only point maybe I left out there was 17 but that's golf.

Q. You were a little bit frustrated when you came out of recording yesterday. Did you iron out everything you needed to?

JOOST LUITEN: Yesterday I played golf well tee-to-green. I couldn't hole the putts. Then it's nice to see that after a couple hours on the putting green, you fix something and I hole a couple of putts. And that's the bonus putts that you need to hole to make scores like this.

Q. I know there's a few shots you'd like to get redone. Good to bring form on a week like this, you must be satisfied.

JOOST LUITEN: You never know when you're going to play well. Struggled a little bit with an injury. It's nice to see the form progressing and that you do it in the right week. We'll see what it will be at the end of the day, but I'm happy with the way I played and I can build on that.

Q. There's no telling what's going to happen today. That's a pretty bunched leaderboard. Do you have a forecast on how things will pan out?

JOOST LUITEN: I think back nine plays easier than the front nine. So I think there will be a couple guys that will go past me. If I finish in the Top 10, I can't complain too much and take it as a good week.

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
