JUSTIN LEONARD: Yeah, I take a lot of good things from this last couple weeks. You know, last week I was able to spend a couple days with Mike Thomas and just little mind things and trying to get a little more rotation in the clubface and stuff like that. Still plenty of things to work on but having a week like this where I hit it so consistently and hit it really good off the tee. You know, I'm excited about what's coming up here the rest of the year.

Q. First time you played heathland golf in a Senior Open Championship over here. Have you fallen in love with Sunningdale?

JUSTIN LEONARD: Yeah. How could you not? It's a beautiful place. And then the golf course, as we talked about earlier in the week, it's just a great balance of there's a lot of strategy to the short holes.
