**Q. Good fight out there; what made it feel like a fight today?**

On 9, there was a moment where I thought it was off the left, then it right off the right when I hit. On 15, it was downwind, then it went just off the right. 16, it swirled for Jon. 17 was fine. There was a few -- 14 was a perfect example. I thought the wind was off the left, considering the last hole, and the wind was off the right and I missed it long left. It's just one of those things that makes it difficult out here, and that's why we love golf.

**Q. You hit driver on 17 into a fairway that you literally have to walk single file on. When do you decide to make those aggressive plays?**

BRYSON DeCHAMBEAU: If I feel crazy enough to do it.
