You never know; hopefully in the near future there's some qualification criteria that that might affect, so to be able to finish as high as possible for the season, it's important. If that happens for the majors, then I'm glad that I was able to play that well.

Q. Did you take a look at all at how Hatton was doing? It was basically you and him --

SERGIO GARCIA: Yeah, obviously I saw that he was playing really well today again, and I saw that he was climbing up the leaderboard.

I felt calm, though. I felt like I was doing a lot of good things and giving myself a lot of chances.

Obviously I missed a couple of chances early on that that

could have taken, but I was in good spirits. I made a couple nice par saves on 10 and 12 and kind of kept me going the right way. It came down to one point at the end of the day, at the end of the year. It shows you how close it is and how good everyone is.
