RICHARD T. LEE: Honestly, I don't think it would be comfortable for any player to have a two-shot lead on the last day.

I think just putting my hat on and just play my golf. Play golf.

**Q. Why do you think it's been happening for you these three rounds? Did you feel like it was going to happen the way it's played out so far for you?**

RICHARD T. LEE: I think I've just been taking advantage on the holes that I can, and definitely on the hard holes try to make pars and try to not make bogeys. I think just how I've been playing the last three days.
