Q. Being in contention again, I know that's not a place that you've been recently, but obviously it's got to feel good.

CHARLEY HULL: Yeah, yeah. Definitely. I've had quite a good start to the season. Was in contention quite a bit.



I played a couple LET events, was in contention there.

Yeah, just feel good going into Scottish and British. Back in contention, especially in a major.

Q. For sure. Those LET events, you tend to play quite a lot of them. What does that do for and you your game?
