MENGHAN LI: I know for the very first time because I have my name on hole-in-one could made a contribution for the charity, so first time to hear about it. Very happy to do the charity thing.

Q. Lastly, what does it mean to be back here after being low amateur last year?

MENGHAN LI: I want to thank the China Golf Association. They offer ver me this wildcard. I could be in the main field. I'm very happy about it. Very happy to back here.
