**Q. End of four days here. Overall what is the mentality heading into the final day of the Olympic competition?**

JOEL GIRRBACH: Well, I tried to be a bit more aggressive to get a better score in, but it didn't work out at all. I had a good start but then I just made too many mistakes, too many bad shots, and at the end, yeah, tough finish for me.

But yeah, it is what it is now. Still a nice week. Not the result I wish for but all in all it was nice to be here.

**Q. Overall, what do you take away from this Olympic experience? What's something you'll keep to yourself the rest of the way?**

JOEL GIRRBACH: I think the whole week, so many new experiences with the Village, with all the surrounding here, with the spectators, with the course. I think it's almost a once-in-a-lifetime memory. I think all in all it was amazing to be here.

**Q. And to be the first Swiss man to tee it up in the men's competition, what does that mean to you?**
