Q. We had Jeremiah up on the podium when the news broke about this trade. He was excited to be playing with you. Could you talk about when did you learn that this trade was going to happen? Q. What does it mean to you now that you've gotten selected here in the draft, made the lottery and your Montverde teammates have all been in the first round this year?

DERIK QUEEN: That's great because you never really get to get this experience. It's really unlikely that basically a super team goes to the same school and all of us go in the first round.

I feel like Liam and Ace definitely should have went higher. But I think it all worked out for us. God has a plan for us. I think it's amazing. All four of us are not going to share the same court at the same time, but all four of us are going to have a chance to play against each other.
