JOSH HART: It's still 0-0 as far as we're concerned. Being up 2-0 means really nothing. This team is going to come out on Monday with an unbelievable amount of energy and desperation, and we've got to be better.

Q: What can you say about the performance from Mikal on both ends of the floor tonight?

JOSH HART: You can't say enough about him. I'm not surprised about it. I don't think anyone else is surprised or should be surprised. That's what he does. He's a winning basketball player. He makes big-time shots, big-time stops. He takes the challenge and he's a hell of a basketball player.

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
