Gave myself chances to save par on those holes I made bogey, but wasn't able to convert and, yeah, just a couple loose shots and couple bad bounces I guess.

COREY CONNERS: Yeah, it was nice. I still felt good about the game and good about things and was just trying to battle hard. Made a great par on 12, actually. Yeah, great to eagle the 13th there. Yeah, feel things feel a lot better when do you that.

COREY CONNERS: Yeah, I felt great. It really was kind of a tricky putt, broke a couple different ways, had some speed to it, but felt like I saw it pretty well and hit a nice putt there, and it's always a bonus to see those drop in.

COREY CONNERS: Yeah, huge honor to represent Canada at the Olympics again. It was a big goal of mine, since playing in Tokyo three years ago, that I really wanted to represent Canada again.
