

Pulled off the drive and hit an unbelievable like punch 3-wood. I started on the left side of the fairway and had to work it around the trees, and I somehow pulled it off. I think it went to like eight feet or something and holed the putt.

Obviously if I don't hole that or don't pull off the shot I'm not in the situation I'm in on 18, but I mean, I'm super grateful





that I was in that situation and that's a positive for sure.
