So try to keep it in front of you on those golf course. This area hasn't had a whole lot of rain, so they're playing really firm and fast over there. I drove around Monday and it hasn't rained since then. So it's going to be a good test tomorrow. The field's really good. But I think that I'm playing some good golf, so I like my chances.

Q. Do you have any like stories from other qualifying that you kind of remember that may come to mind?

LUKE LIST: My first one ever was when I was 18 in Atlanta at Settindown Creek. And Billy Andrade made it that year, so that was kind of cool to get to know him. He was really supportive of me there and then when we went up to Olympia fields. That was a long time ago now. So, yeah, they're never easy days, but try to make light of it and just make as many birdies as you can.
