Q. What do you say about this match? Hard fought until the bitter end.

BRYSON DeCHAMBEAU: Definitely. Pretty good game all day. We didn't play our best, obviously, but just a bit rusty. Q. How was the game mentally? Were you nervous, butterflies there? You haven't played in a while.

To be honest I'm very happy and content with the place that I'm at right now, and I feel like I'm progressing in the right direction. I thought there might be a moment where it got really tired and fatigued, but to be honest it's still really solid, so I'm proud of my hand, proud of my body, proud of my attitude.
