It's kind of right back after it, and the greens are firm, and the wind was going to blow a little bit, so I knew it was going to be hard mentally. It's hard coming back after last week. You just put so much into that tournament. But this is a great tournament. It's a good chance for me, so glad I could get out and hit some good shots today.

Q. I heard you got up early to get turkey Monday morning; does a successful hunt put you in the right mindset for tournament w

BRIAN HARMAN: Yeah, it's what I like to do. I like to get out and spend time in the woods, especially this time of year. Turkey hunting is one of my favorite things to do, and I knew I was going to have to play all week this week, so I've got a sweet wife that let me go Monday morning and go get one.

Q. What clubs did you hit on No. 8 and No. 16 for those birdies?

BRIAN HARMAN: 8, driver off the tee and then a 6-iron from about 185 yards.
