Q. Great opening round 6-under 65, tied for second here at the Palmetto Championship at Congaree. Talk to us a little bit about your day. Certainly a good stretch there to get started on the opening nine.

And the guys at this level, they're so good that they need one practice round and they kind of know where they're going. So I don't know if it's really too much of an advantage or disadvantage. You're going to have guys no matter who they are shoot low every single day, so...
