**Q. Birdies on 16, 17 and 18. I saw the approach into 17. That's a big par-4, you stuffed it in there. Was it just a perfect number?**

JACKSON SUBER: Yeah, honestly I thought 8 was going to be a little short, but I thought it was a good club and kind of kept it in a good spot. The wind was down and a little off the right, so I said to my caddie, I'm just going to aim right at it and try to hit it right at it, let the wind take it a little bit left. The wind didn't really move it much, started right at it and ended up being pretty close.

**Q. We haven't really seen this golf course like this. Now having six competitive Canadian Open rounds, do you have a different perspective, a different view of the golf course playing in those types of conditions because it was hard and blowing?**

JACKSON SUBER: Yeah, it was tough. These are the only two Canadian Opens I played in are here, and it's definitely tough. It's long. You got to hit a lot of really good long irons and good drives. If you're not hitting good drives it's going to be a tough day. But the fairways are fair. If you hit good ones it's going to end up in the fairway.

**Q. You got engaged this year, correct?**

JACKSON SUBER: Correct.

**Q. Do we have a date on the calendar yet?**

JACKSON SUBER: Not yet. No date, no location. I need her to help me find one sooner.

**Q. Are we chatting about this? Is this like a dinner conversation around the table? Have you started a list?**
