**Q. With the wind direction today, is the start better than the finish or is it just as hard figuring it out down breeze today because it's so stiff?**

JESPER SVENSSON: Yeah, it all depends on the trajectory, especially wedges downwind was quite tricky. If you don't get it up in the air it doesn't really get that much help. But, yeah, the strength was definitely more today than yesterday. Yeah, it's nice having this being done.

**Q. Your putter was great, you scrambled well, I saw your up-and-down at 17. There's so many little things dictating the golf ball today with that wind, how were you able to keep things calm around the putting surfaces?**

JESPER SVENSSON: Yeah, 17 was one of those. I hit trying to a wedge in, I didn't get the help that I wanted, it came out a little bit too low. But, yeah, it's just a matter of committing to the lines, because it can change quite often. You get a little bit of a side wind and the line changes on 'em. So I think it's just trying to keep the first putt as close as possible to the hole and yeah, just do some good rolls.

**Q. Real good spot after 36. Sweden is a good soccer country, are you watching the World Cup, are you into this?**

JESPER SVENSSON: I'm not that much into soccer, actually. But it's fun to have them in the World Cup.

**Q. Are you a hockey guy?**

JESPER SVENSSON: Yeah, yeah, no, I'm much more into hockey than soccer. So, yeah, hoping for the Canes to bring it home.
