THE MODERATOR: Bogey-free 65. What did you like about your round?

THE MODERATOR: First time at this tournament. Had you played Dunes before prior to this week?

ANDREW PUTNAM: Yeah, never been here. I heard good things. Everybody who has played this tournament said how much they loved the course, so excited to come and check it out. Didn't disappoint.

ANDREW PUTNAM: No, we came here in college a few times. Played TPC Myrtle Beach. It was a long ways from Pepperdine, but the courses here are great.

THE MODERATOR: Any specific memories from the starts in college?

ANDREW PUTNAM: I think it was Coastal Carolina's event, and Dustin Johnson was playing. I think probably my freshman year. The TPC Myrtle Beach is extremely hard. I always played pretty good here, so I don't know if that's a thing, but yeah, I've had some good starts.

THE MODERATOR: Ryan mentioned between the three of you, you guys were bogey-free until the final. How did it help to kind of have momentum going with that group?





ANDREW PUTNAM: We were all playing well, which obviously helps the momentum. Ryan kind of turned it on towards the end, and I was the beginning. Victor did too. It's nice when your whole group is playing well.

Q. You talked about course conditions and how you enjoyed it. Can you talk specifically about what you saw out there condition-wise and just what this course offers from a player's perspective?

ANDREW PUTNAM: There was very little wind. That was nice. It can be tricky when the wind comes up. The rough was just short enough that you can get a club on it, but you can catch quite a few flyers if you're not careful.

Down green, the greens are extremely fast. You can hit putts five feet by pretty easily.

Q. What's it mean to be in an event like this and kick things off the way you did today? Is it challenging to have a day like this with expectations, or is it nice to have a day like today that you can feel like you can build off of moving forward?

ANDREW PUTNAM: Actually one of my sponsors was launching their new shoe, the Lux Mavens today, so I felt some pressure. I need to play well. I'm the only one who wears them. I'm glad I can make them proud.
