Q. Here with Søren Kjeldsen and Alex Cejka. I want to start with you. It's one thing to get subbed in, it's another thing when you're playing for like your guy, and Bernhard Langer was your guy. What was it like when they said, hey, you do have clubs with you, right? Do you want to play today?

SØREN KJELDSEN: Yeah, pretty special. I came in prepared, and I knew that Bernhard wasn't feeling great. So I've been preparing nicely, but yeah, he is my man.

Q. Alex, does it change anything for you when they go, hey, I know you're supposed to play with a guy who wins everything out here on the PGA TOUR Champions, but you're going to be playing with Søren instead. And he's not bad.

ALEX CEJKA: He's not bad. He's a great player. The only thing I had to change is the language. Instead of German, I had to speak now English so everybody understands.

We've done this many times. We're really good friends. Bernhard or Søren, it didn't matter. We still played well. We got a couple of points on the board, and we're excited.

Q. You guys were talking earlier today about this. Is there a number in your head like, hey, let's make sure we get nine points or try to get ten points. Was there a number in your head that you're trying to get today?

SØREN KJELDSEN: I think you're right. Nine is certainly a number. If you get above nine, you've done well. It is a little bit of a benchmark.

Q. Talk to me about how you guys fed off of each



other out there today because you ham and egged it pretty good.

ALEX CEJKA: We were lucky. We played the right holes the right way. It's stupid to make two birdies on the same hole. It's like I made a birdie, he made a birdie on the next one. So the combination today on the front nine in the morning matches were great.

Q. We saw Bernhard warming up over there on the driving range. Are you going to do the matches?

SØREN KJELDSEN: We don't know yet. It's the captain's choice.

ALEX CEJKA: I don't know. We don't know yet.

Q. But if you're going to go, you're ready to go for the six-somes in the afternoon?

SØREN KJELDSEN: Absolutely. I love playing with this guy.
