SHANE LOWRY: We got unlucky today. We probably didn't play our best but we hit some good shots and got bad breaks. I feel like -- 80 yard in the middle of the fairway on the last and they made an easy par. We probably should have given them a better match than we did but it is what it is.

Now try to get a couple points in the last few matches, go out tomorrow and give it our best and see if we can get a lead going into the singles.

Q. Tough with the fans when they get going like that?

RORY McILROY: Yeah, they feed off the momentum of the crowd obviously and yeah, they have just -- I mean, the last two sessions, Xander, Patrick, played wonderful, and Tony -- I haven't seen Tony put as good as that in a long time.
